#### **Scope and Content Note:**

Two 7" reels of ¼" audiotape containing oral history interviews with Alphonse Marquis of Edmundston, New Brunswick and with Agnes Bellefleur Cyr of Madawaska, Maine. Submitted for a course at the University of Maine at Fort Kent in the Fall of 1974.

The interview with Mr. Marquis is in French and it's about life and work during the Great Depression which started in 1929 and lasted till the 1940s. Mr. Marquis was 69 years old at the time of the interview in 1974.

The interview with Agnes Bellefleur Cyr of Madawaska is in French and it's about her life in the 1900s. Mrs Cyr was 95 years old at the time of the interview in 1974.

**Order and Arrangement:** The reels were found in a drawer at the Acadian Archives in 2009. In October 2010, the archives staff transferred the content of the reels on archival gold compact discs for preservation. (see concordances below)

White label compact discs were also made for community patron use and were placed with the Paradis Folklore Project collection in the media section of the stacks.
