Provenance: This collection consisted originally of 27 home disc recordings made in the late 1940s. This collection is owned by Joseph Patrick Bourgoin who assigned the Acadian Archives/Archives acadiennes the right to produce a preservation sound recording in February of 1995.

Date Range: 1949

Physical Characteristics/Condition: 27 home disc recordings made in the late 1940s. the discs were in poor condition due to flaking of the various coatings. All playable tracks were copied by the Archives staff onto 1/4" audio tape reels. Cassette masters were then prepared from the reels.

Access: There are no restrictions on this collection

Scope and Content Note:

The collection consists of 59 tracks of songs and instrumental music recorded in 1949 by Roland Belanger, at the home of Patrick Bourgoin of Frenchville, Maine. The recordings document the music of the Patrick Bourgoin, the father of the donor, Joseph Patrick Bourgoin.

Provenance:

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Order and Arrangement: 27 home disc recordings made in the late 1940s. the discs were in poor condition due to flaking of the various coatings. Of 77 total tracks, 59 tracks were playable. These 59 playable tracks were copied by the Archives staff onto 3 ¼" audio tape reels. 3 cassette masters were then prepared from the reels. Disc numbers and sides were arbitrarily assigned by archives staff; no order was evident from disc labels.
