Introduction: The 1860 census was also called "The Eight Census." The census of 1860 was taken under the act of May 23, 1850, upon the recommendation of the Secretary of the Interior that the provisions of that act should be adhered to, following the requirement for the taking of the eighth or any subsequent c3ensus under its provisions, if no law therefore was passed before January 1 of the year in which the census was require to be taken, under the constitution. ...the Secretary of the Interior on June 1, 1860, appointed Mr. Joseph C. g. Kennedy as Superintendent of the Eighth Census.

The same schedules of inquiry were used as in 1850, with a few additions and extensions, the most important being those on the schedule for free inhabitants, which required that the "profession, occupation, or trade of each person, male and female..."

Scope and content: The 1860 Census gives out "name; age; sex; race; value of real estate; value of personal estate; occupation; birthplace; whether married within the year; school attendance; literacy; whether deaf and dumb; blind, insane, idiotic, pauper, or convict; number of slave houses. Supplemental schedules for slaves, and persons who died during the year." ²
