Historical and Biographical Information

Agricultural schedules are scattered among a variety of archives in which they were deposited by the National Archives and Records Service. Most are not indexed, and only a few had been microfilmed until recently. The schedules for 1890 were destroyed by fire, and those for 1900 and 1910 were destroyed by congressional order.¹
