This collection consists of a thesis written by Bonita A. Freeman, titled "Frenchville, Maine, and its Traditions of Folk Medicine." The thesis was presented to the Honors Committee at an unnamed school for thesis credit in Hr. 54 on May 10, 1968. The thesis

"is basically a documented dictionary of folk medicine in Frenchville. The cures have been recorded, cross-referenced, and compared with other carefully selected dictionaries of folk medicine." The thesis also includes an index to individuals mentioned in the paper; it appears this index was added to the thesis at a later time by an unnamed source.
