Biographical information:

Margaret McBreairty McBreairty Hughey was born on May 22, 1906, the daughter of Thomas McBreairty and Eunice (Kelly) McBreairty. She married Elbridge McBreairty on June 26, 1923; they had nine children. Elbridge died in 1951 and Margaret remarried to Phil Hughey on August 14, 1957. Margaret died on October 20, 1997.

Scope and content:

This collection consists of a transcript created by Darrell McBreairty of Margaret McBreairty McBreairty Hughey's diary. According to a note included with the diary, Mrs. Hughey kept a number of diaries from 1932 until 1997; in 1984 she compiled all of the diaries into one bound volume. Upon her passing, Darrel McBreairty created a transcript of this diary. While the original compiled diary was not in chronological order, the transcript of entries has been recorded in chronological order. The entries primarily pertain to daily life, family, and friends. At the end of the diary is a list of ice jams from 1926 to 1996. Also included are lists of family members (by family) and their birth and death dates. These were most likely compiled by Darrell McBreairty, as they include dates beyond the diary's inclusive dates.
