**Biographical information:**

Wilmer A. Saucier was born on January 7, 1925 in Fort Kent, the son of Alfred and Emma Theriault Saucier. After being education in a one-room schoolhouse, Saucier worked for Great Northern Paper Company as a woodcutter and a foreman. He was also a supervisor for Glendale Siding after his retirement from Great Northern. Saucier had four

children with his wife Bernice Bouchard (1924-2008). Saucier died in 1994 at the age of 69.

***Scope and content:***

This collection consists of a photograph of President Richard Spath, Wilmer Saucier and Tom Pinkham of Great Northern Paper, David Pagnucci of Northern Maine Medical Center, and Academic Dean Roland Burns on an occasion related to the University of Maine at Fort Kent Nursing Program. Richard Spath served as president of UMFK from 1971 until 1986, giving this photograph an estimated date of the 1970s.
