Biographical information:

Gary Saucier was born on July 13, 1948, the son of Wilmer A. Saucier (1925-1994) and Bernice Bouchard (1924-2008). Bernice was born in Fort Kent, the daughter of Herbert

Bouchard and Aurore Marquis from St. Hilaire. Bernice was a member of the 1943 graduating class at Fort Kent High School. She later worked as a registrar at the Registry of Deeds.

Scope and content:

This collection consists of the Fort Kent High School class of 1943 will, as well as a typed copy of the will (the original is rolled and fragile), a list of the class members with their married names (if women) and addresses, a photograph of class members at their 50th reunion in 1993, and a newspaper clipping from the June 23, 1993 *Saint John Valley Times* (page 35) containing the same photograph and listing the class members depicted: Lauretta Dumond Babkirk; Therese Daigle Nadeau; Bernice Bouchard Saucier; Clotilde Dumond Theriault; Bertha Sirois Lozier; Roland Daigle; Leo Gregoire; Ammy Deprey; and Lorenzo Daigle.

Order and Arrangement:

The photograph and the newspaper clipping in folder 1 were transferred into an archival sleeve for protection and left in folder 1.

The rolled class will measures 8.5 in. wide x 37.5 in. long and had a wooden piece at both end stapled to the paper. The staples were taken out and the wood pieces were discarded. We were able to transfer the unrolled class will into an archival sleeve for protection and preservation. Because of the length of the unrolled document, the archives staff had to store it in the map drawers with shelf list number V6-261 referring to drawer number 6 of the map drawers and document number 261.

The typescript of the class will was left in folder 2 for patron use.
