Organizational history:

The Madawaska Acadian Festival, held annually during the last week of June in Madawaska, Maine, began in 1978. The festival celebrates the Acadian heritage of Madawaska and the Saint John River Valley of both Maine and New Brunswick, Canada.

Scope and content:

This collection consists of a certificate of appreciation presented to the University of Maine at Fort Kent for "meritorious services rendered" during the First Acadian Day on June 28th, 1978. The certificate is signed by the Madawaska Historical Society president, the Chamber of Commerce president, the Acadian Day chairman, and the Chamber of Commerce chairman.
