This collection consists of an unidentified merchant's daybook. The merchant may have been from Fort Kent. The daybook, through unknown circumstances, came into the

possession of the Fort Kent Boy Scouts and was on display at the Fort Kent blockhouse for many years.

The daybook covers the period of December 30, 1887 through July 19, 1888. It contains daily notations of charge accounts for the store. Names of prosperous and well-known citizen appear in the book.
