This collection consists of a typescript of recipes entitled, "French-American and French Canadian Recipes." Recipes included are : buckwheat cakes/galettes de sarrasin;

buckwheat pancakes/ploys; pea soup/soupe aux pois; lambs' quarters/poulet gras; lambs' quarters soup/soupe aux poulet gras; potage Normandy style/potage normande; green bean salad/salade aux haricots; salad Normandy style/salade a la mode normande; vinaigrette sauce/sauce vinaigrette; dandelion salad/salade aux pissenlits; salted onion tops/herbes sale; Bernard's potatoes/patates à Bernard; beets Canadian style/betteraves a la mode du Canada; turnip compote/compote au navet; pork pie/tourtière; sugar pie/tarte au sucre; maple sugar pie/tarte au sucre d'erable; molasses pie/les tarte a farlouche; pie crust/croute de tarte; dumplings in maple syrup/grand-pères. The recipes were compiled by Emily B. Evans, Extension Agent, in Fort Kent Maine on July 25, 1979. They came from individuals from the following Maine towns: Van Buren, Soldier Pond, Lille, and Sinclair.
