Paul Coulombe received a grant by the State of Maine for 71 acres of land in New Canada. He had moved from Canada where he worked as a shingle maker. His son Alexander "Douge" Coulombe was the father of Louis and the grandfather of James. James Coulombe married Diana; he inherited the land.

This collection consists of property records concerning land in New Canada that has passed through generations of the Coulombe family. Included are mortgages, quitclaims, deeds, receipts, resolutions of liens, and other legal documents. They span from 1898 through 1979, with the majority from the 1950s.
