**Biographical information:**

Anathalie Hébert was born on July 4, 1861 in St. David, Maine, the daughter of Honore and Henriette Michaud Hébert. She married Joseph Cyr (1856-1922) on February 1, 1880, in St. David. She had six children: Eugenie Cyr (1882-1882); Denis Cyr (1883-

1953); Adeline Cyr (1885-1891); Alfred Guillaume Cyr (1887-1887); Alexis Cyr (1884-1889); and Marie Delina Cyr (1908-1989). Anathalie died on March 2, 1948.

***Scope and content:***

This collection consists of the diary of Anathalie Hébert Cyr, kept between approximately 1874 and 1885. In addition to personal entries on various social, religious, and family matters, the diary also includes transcripts and paraphrases of short stories, fables, and news articles. The diary contains entries in both French and English. Also included in the collection are photocopied portions of the diary, a Cyr family genealogy compiled by Claudette Cyr, and digital copies of images depicting Nathalie Hébert Cyr, Marie Délima Cyr Crotto, and a photograph of Simon H and Josette Daigle with Roger Paradis (UMFK professor).
