## Scope and content:

This collection consists of a full score composition by Harrison Roper of Houlton Maine, composed for the Northern Maine Chamber Orchestra and completed in March 2000. The

composition is "based partly on ballads from the Acadian Archives, University of Maine at Fort Kent." It is comprised of three movements: 1. First light--Sunrise--To work!--Sunset (Jour de naissant--lever de soleir--Au travail!--coucher de soleil); 2. A Tragedy (Complainte); 3. Healthy Youth, On a Really Fine Day (un Jour merveilleux--amusons-nous!). The entire performance lasts approximately 15 minutes; the composition was first performed on April 1, 2000. Some pages of the score have footnotes explaining the origins of particular sections of music.
