The St. Francis Lumber Company manufactured and distributed lumber, laths, shingles, railway ties, and cedar poles. Their mill was located in Cottage Siding, Maine.

Scope and content:

This collection consists of a photocopy of a logging contract between Ransford Kelley of Allagash, Maine, and St. Francis Lumber Company of St. Francis, Maine, dated December 1, 1936. The contract states that the company is hiring Kelley as a contractor to cut, haul, mark, and deliver spruce, fir, cedar, and pine logs cut from lands owned by the company in T17 R11, Wheatland and Coe.
