Scope and content:

This collection consists of a music recording made in 1990 for a Cyr family reunion, possibly held in New Brunswick, Canada. The included songs are sung by Aimé Leblanc

and his wife Pauline (Pauline Poitras) and the chorale St-Georges of Grand-Sault, New Brunswick. Also included in the collection is a songbook, entitled *Chants de la famille Cyr*, containing the lyrics to the recorded songs. The included songs, all but one of which in French, are “La Chanson Des Cyr,” “Les Trois Choques,” “Le Pêcheur Acadien,” “Dear Hearts and Gentle People,” “Viens Voir L’Acadie,” “Les Cyr’s Siegas,” “Mon Village,” “Au Fond Des Campagnes,” “Y’a Une Etoile Pour Vous,” “Unissons Nos Voix,” and “Mots de Remerciement” (capitalization depicts that used in the table of contents).
