The Saint John Valley Times was founded by Emile Genest and Joe Falter, both of Thomaston, Connecticut, and published its first issue on 2 October 1957. It has been owned and published since 1973 by Cleveland Newspapers (formerly Walls Newspaper Inc.) of Cleveland Tennessee.
