Organizational history:

The Daughters of Wisdom, a Catholic order of women, was founded in the early 1700s by Marie Louise Trichet. In 1904, the order moved their ministries from France, arriving in northern Maine that year. The order presently serves in 22 countries. The Daughters of Wisdom serve in Frenchville, Aroostook County, Maine.

Scope and content:

This collection consists of an ordinal, *Ceremonial*, for the Daughters of Wisdom. It was printed by M. Lescuyer & Son, Printers at Lyons (London), on May 23, 1958, under the Archbishop of Hartford, Henry J. O'Brien. The ordinal contains mass instructions for the sister for a mass held for the order's novices. It includes directional materials, responses, and recitations. Portions of the ordinal are in Latin.
