Biographical information: Harry Rush was a French teacher at Schenck High School, East Millinocket, Maine, 1968-2001.

Scope and content:

This collection consists primarily of materials pertaining to the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary in Rimouski, Québec, and their founder, Sister Mary Elisabeth Turgeon. The collection includes a variety of materials, including publications, prayer cards, two pieces of correspondence, photographs, and slides. Other materials in the collection concern St. Luce Parish in Frenchville, Maine, St. Mary's College Shrine in Van Buren, Maine, and New Orleans.

The three albums of slides contain images of various places along with handwritten notes pertaining to the slides. They are arranged by series (by Harry Rush). The original volumes were placed into archival albums; while the original order was maintained, what was labeled as volumes originally now is split differently into the archival albums. The original volumes were labeled "French slides."
