Organizational history: The Maine State Highway Commission was appointed on July 19, 1913 in accordance with Section 3, Chapter 130, P.L., 1913. Three members were initially appointed.

In 1939, the Bureau of Public Roads (BPR) was renamed the Public Roads Administration (PRA) and moved under the Federal Works Agency. The increased number of vehicles on the roads, whose distance had also increased, called for better highways and regulations.

Scope and content:

This collection consists of seven Aroostook County, Maine, general highway maps 2, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10, created in 1938 and printed with updates in 1945 by the State Highway Commission, Planning Survey Division, in Cooperation with the Public Roads Administration, Federal Works Agency. The maps are all stamped "Luke Pelletier, Madawaska, Maine." Each map has a key map legend for the geographic location of each of the maps within the state of Maine.
