Organizational history: In June 2007, members of the Violette family loaned to the Acadian Archives/Archives acadiennes at the University of Maine at Fort Kent archival copies of scrapbooks created by Marcella Belanger Violette. These scrapbooks chronicled Marcella Bélanger Violette's lifetime of public service. The scrapbooks, comprised of more than 3,000 pages, cover the time period from 1920 through 2004. A wide range of topics are included in the collection with key areas being: the town of Van Buren, the Saint John Valley, Franco-Americans, the Acadians, Bilingualism, Education, Politics, St. Bruno's Church in Van Buren, the Good Sheppard Sisters, the Allagash Wilderness Waterway and the Violette family. Each volume is filled with photos, newspaper articles, letters, cards, telegrams, postcards, brochures, and other items Marcella carefully selected for inclusion.

The Acadian Archives/Archives acadiennes created an exhibition to celebrate the lives and contributions of Marcella Belanger and Elmer Violette and to provide a venue for visitors to view these scrapbooks. The exhibit, which ran October 26 through December 31, 2007, consisted of displays of the scrapbooks, various ephemera on loan from the Violette family, audio and video interviews conducted by archives staff with people close to the Violettes, and panels describing the lives and contributions of the Violettes. These panels were created by UMFK IT staff member Steve Michaud and library staff member Leslie Kelly from materials contained within the scrapbooks along with materials and information provided by the Violette family. The exhibit has a long-term presence on the Acadian Archives/Archives acadiennes website.

Scope and content:

This collection consists of 15 panels created for the exhibit, audio and video interviews with people close to Marcella and Elmer Violette, personal video and slides from the Violette family. Many of these materials were used in the creation of the exhibit. The exhibit materials include interviews with Don Niccol; Louise Ansari; Dennis, Marc, and Tom Violette, and Frank Murray. The CD "Elmer Violette and Marcella Belanger Violette" interviews and speeches contains an interview with Elmer; Elmer's campaign speech on rural America; a campaign speech in French; campaign radio spots; an endorsement by Edmund Muskie; and Marcella Belanger Violette's speech "My Valley, My People" in both French and English. One of the campaign recordings come from an original recording of the following: a Freeport, Maine rally in 1966. In addition, the collection contains field notes collected by Lisa Ornstein, former director of the Acadian Archives/Archives acadiennes in 1991, describing the Violette family history and homestead, as well as regional parish development.

The collection also includes a video, "Remembering the Contributions of Marcella and Elmer Violette" created by the Acadian Archives/Archives acadiennes, and images of the exhibit.

This collection is arranged into 3 series: exhibit panels; portraits; and audio/visual materials.
