**Biographical information:**

Ralph St. John, the son of Louis St. John (1917-1989) and Dolores (Daigle) St. John (born 1922), was born on August 29, 1942 in Fort Kent, Maine. He graduated from Assumption Preparatory School in Wooster, Massachusetts and received his B.S. in Mathematics from the University of Massachusetts. St. John earned his M.A. in Statistics from the University of Massachusetts and both an M.A. and his Ph.D. in Mathematical Statistics from the University of Wisconsin. After a brief career at IBM, St. John became a Professor of Applied Statistics at Bowling Green State University in Ohio. There, he created the Statistical Consulting Center. St. John is an original founder of Bowling Green's youth and interscholastic soccer programs.

Ralph married Marcia (Marcy) Ellen Domergue (b. 1946) on June 21, 1969, in Pittsburg, Pennsylvania. Together, they raised two children: Matthew and Jessica.

**Scope and content:**

This collection consists of genealogical materials for many family names within the St. John Valley region of Maine: Adams; Albert; Anctil; Berube; Blanchette; Bosse; Bouchard; Boucher; Bourgoin; Castonguay; Cyr; Daigle; De Baillon; Gagnon; Gardner; Guerette; Guimond; La Forge; Levesque; Marquis; Martin; Michaud; Miville; Morin; Ouellette; Paradis; Plourde; Reou;

Roy; St. Jean; St. John; Tardif; and Voisine. These materials were compiled or created by Ralph St. John. Also included in the collection are correspondence both to Ralph St. John and to his mother, Dolores St. John, as well as photographs of family members, places, and gravesites.

This collection is divided into 3 series: Genealogical materials; Correspondence; Images.

The images series has been divided into 4 subseries: People (individuals and groups); Places and items; Cemetery and headstone images; and Images removed from correspondence. The majority of the images are undated.

A 22 inch by 26 inch framed portrait of Achille Michaud and one 2 inch diameter white metal pin with blue letters printed with "I Have Daigle Roots", received by mail from the St. John family on October 16, 2013 were added to the collection.

***Processing action:***

All of **series 3 photos** were taken out of their folders and placed in an archival photo album with shelf list number UP-403. The photos were numbered and placed in a different order which was requested by the St. John family who came to visit from Bowling Green, Ohio on September 18 and 19, 2013. Some pictures were taken out of the collection by the family and others were

added by the family. The photo collection has been divided in 2 parts, requested by the family:  
The Ancil / St-Jean / St. John family and the Daigle family.

\*\* Item 170 from series 3, the framed portrait of Thomas Achille Michaud, was taken out of the wooden frame and inserted in a clear mylar protective sleeve and placed in an archival box with shelf list number BM-403.

Notes: Thomas Achille Michaud was born April 2, 1882 in Fort Kent, Maine, son of Achille Michaud and Zoe Michaud. Thomas Achille married 30 April 1911 to Clarisse Marguerite Ouellet in Fort Kent, Maine. It states in a WWI war draft record that his "left arm lost at shoulder" dated "Sept. 12, 1918".
