Camille Lausier was born December 13, 1907, in St. David, the son of Alexis and Julie Dionne Lausier. He married Irene Daigle (1908-1954) of Fort Kent. He married Ella Bouchard Bard (1900-1986) on May 1, 1960. Lausier died on July 14, 1996.

Ella Bouchard was born February 25, 1900. She married Alphe Honore Bard (1898-1950) on July 22, 1918. She married Camille Lausier on May 1, 1960. Ella died on January 16, 1986.
