Historical information: On May 9, 1973, a corporation was formed and named, “Notre Heritage Vivant”. The name representing the eastern part of the Saint. John Valley in Aroostook County of Maine. It encompasses the communities of Grand Isle, Van Buren, Hamlin, and Cyr

Plantation. The purpose of the corporation is to foster, promote, and encourage interest in the history and in preserving the heritage and culture of the people of the region. Many fundraising projects were held and with the help of generous supporters who donated land and buildings the Acadian Village was underway. Gilles Nadeau was chosen as the village designer.

The society received a CETA grant and a matching grant from the Maine State Bicentennial Commission. When the weather permitted, volunteers started getting the land ready and moving buildings one at a time or constructing new buildings on the site of the present village.

“The Acadian Village contains a group of buildings depicting an Acadian Heritage. A culture that is very distinguished in exposing the skills of art, courage, faith, and the hardship our ancestors had in establishing the Saint John River Valley.”

Historical notes: The **Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA)**, was a United States federal law enacted by the Congress, and signed into law by President Richard Nixon December 28, 1973 to train workers and provide them with jobs in the public service.)

CETA funds were administered in a decentralized fashion by state and local governments, on the assumption that they could best determine local needs.

The program offered work to those with low incomes and the long-term unemployed as well as summer jobs to low income high school students. Full-time jobs were provided for a period of 12 to 24 months in public agencies or private not for profit organizations. The intent was to impart a marketable skill that would allow participants to move to an unsubsidized job. It was an extension of the Works Progress Administration program from the 1930s.¹

Scope and content: This collection consists of text, colored and black and white photos, and copies of photographs illustrating, from the beginning, the de-construction of historic buildings, the transport, and re-assembly of those historic buildings that encompasses the Acadian Village in Van Buren, Maine. The photographs and copies of photographs are of different sizes. The copies were placed on a tabloid size sheets and laminated. The laminated sheets were left as is so not to damage the paper. Through these photographs, you can follow the progression of the Acadian Village named in honor of all of the Acadian ancestors who established themselves and their families in this valley around 1785.
