Biographical information:

Allen Jackson, the son of Romeo Jackson, Sr. and Jennie McBreairty grew up in the small town of Allagash. His home was a remote place referred to as the Head of the Rapids. Summers were a delight, since the family was right on the St. John River, which Allen refers to as their playground. After high school graduation, he joined the Army and was stationed at Howard Air Force Base in the Canal Zone (Panama) where there was a small Army annex called Fort Kobe and that's where he spent the next 32 months of his life. Allen says that life was good, the climate was excellent and work was busy as the 193 Infantry Brigade Headquarters clerk. He left Panama for a two-month stay in California, at Fort Ord,

followed by temporary duty to Fort Meade, Virginia, and left the service from there. He lived in Connecticut for a few years and worked at various places then moved back to Maine.

Allen has lived in Fort Kent for the past 20 years as a disabled Veteran, and have no thoughts of moving to any other place. Allen's passions are working in genealogy tracing family history and collecting and sharing old photos of the areas, i.e. Allagash and St. Francis, Maine. He helped the Allagash Historical Society and Museum in getting a new building and in providing donated items that are currently displayed in the museum. He served as Vice President of the Allagash Historical Society and worked as a tour guide for several years.

Allen is involved with several projects as member of the Allagash Historical Society and the Maine Acadian Heritage Council.

Scope and content: This collection consists of 87 black and white images of people from the Allagash and St. Francis, Maine regions from the 1930s to the 1950s. Many of the photographs are a reproduction from ferrotype/tintypes format, which shows some deterioration. This is a digital collection.
