**Biographical information:** Ernest J. Gendreau was born February 17, 1927, to Joseph and Edith (Clavette) Gendreau in Madawaska, Maine. One of fourteen children, he could not help but form bonds with people. He was a veteran of World War II and served in Italy. On August 26, 1947, he married Lucille Plourde and together they raised four children, Fernand, Linda, John, and Allen. He loved to play his harmonica and his favorite song was 'You Are My Sunshine". He loved fishing, hunting, and snowmobiling.

His ability to relate was more complex. As a farmer (potato grower), he was inextricably tied to the land. Season after season, he put his entire livelihood in the ground, relinquished control to forces of nature and his faith. Working the land requires perspective; he lived his life grounded in the belief that he was a very small part of a much larger world. His daughter think he believed with every fiber of his being that each small part mattered and could, when joined with other small parts, add up to something meaningful and amazing.

He was compassionate and chose gratitude and joy whenever he could. For that reason, he was a people magnet. He loved his family, friends, grandkids, great grandkids, and great grandkids. He loved to laugh and to tease. He was a kid at heart and children were drawn to him.

As per his daughter, Linda, Ernest's last several years were not something he would have chosen. We have to acknowledge the courage and resolve with which he faced a disease that kept him trapped. We owe it to him to remember what came before, and keep those memories in the forefront.

*Scope and content:* This collection consists of obituary cards, prayer cards, 'thank you' cards, and a few newspaper clippings. The obituary cards are mostly from the St. John Valley.
