Biographical information: Fred T. Bouchard was born in Fort Kent, Maine on June 4, 1896, the son of Joseph Bouchard and Sarah Desjardin. He graduated from the Madawaska Training School in 1913 before attending the Shaw's Business College in Bangor, Maine. Mr. Bouchard was a World War I veteran. He began working for the U.S. Immigration Border Patrol in 1924. He was stationed in Marine City and then Detroit Michigan, before receiving a promotion to technical advisor at the U.S. Consulate in Cologne Germany in 1926. Fred married Iva G. Daigle

of Fort Kent, Maine in Cologne on August 15, 1927. They had two daughters, Sarah Jane and Mary Ellen. In June 1930, Fred was assigned to Fort Kent and the next year he became the immigration officer in charge of the Madawaska office. He held this position until his retirement in 1961. Mr. Bouchard passed away on August 12, 1981.

Scope and content: This collection consists of a 50^{th} Golden Anniversary Award from the Fort Kent State Teachers College Alumni Association given to Fred T. Bouchard by Alumni Association president, Emery Labbe in 1963. This award is in a bottle green color binder measuring 9.5 x 7.5 inch. In the binder, is a black and white photograph, 7 x 5 inch, of the class of 1913 from the Fort Kent State Teachers College.

There are two additional photographs in this collection: a 4 x 5 inch black and white photograph of Joseph Bouchard and Sarah Desjardin dit Roy; a 7 x 5 inch black and white 1963bphotograph of seven members of the class of 1913 at the Fort Kent State Teachers College. Fred T. Bouchard and Iva Daigle Bouchard are at the far right on the photograph. The other individuals have not been identified.
