Collection Description

Historical and Biographical Information

The World Acadian Congress, or Le Congrès mondial acadien, is an international event held every five years since 1994 reflecting diversity and vitality of the Acadian and Cajun culture. Its mission is to bring together the Acadian diaspora from around the world through a series of family reunions, conferences and events taking place over a two-week period. Its creator was André Boudreau in 1994.

The fifth Congress was held along the Canada–United States border; co-hosted by Maine's Aroostook County in the United States and its neighboring counties in Canada (Témiscouata in Quebec, and Victoria, Madawaska and Restigouche Counties in New Brunswick). The 2014 World Acadian Congress took place from August 8 to 24, 2014. The theme was *A cadia of the Lands and Forests / L'Acadie des terres et forêts*.

The three major events for the World Acadian Congress were: 1) opening ceremonies held in northwestern New Brunswick on August 8, 2014; 2) the Acadian National Holiday celebrated in Maine (USA) on August 15; 3) the closing ceremonies held in Témiscouata, Quebec, on August 24. The Congress President was Émilien Nadeau and the general director was Léo-Paul Charest.

Scope and Content

This collection consists of documents, pamphlets, maps, printed materials, memorabilia, photographs, newspaper articles, audio-visual materials, and banners that were created for the 2014 World Acadian Congress starting in 2008 with pre-congress events and lasting through the disassembling of the Organizing Committee in 2015. These items were generated to track all events: meetings, conferences, ceremonies, family reunions, concerts, religious ceremonies, etc. that took place during the years mentioned above.

The number of participants were estimated to be around 200,000 in three host regions: Northwest New Brunswick, Témiscouata in the Province of Quebec, and Northern Maine. The theme of the three host regions was *Acadie des terres et forêts / Acadia of the Lands and Forests*.

The theme song was *Mon tour de te bercer* sung by Roch Voisine and Natasha St-Pier.

The official opening ceremonies took place in Edmundston, N.B. on August 8, 2014. Acadian National Day (August 15), Tintamarre and a mega-show took place in Madawaska, Maine. The master of ceremonies for the mega show was Zachary Richard. The closing ceremonies were held in Témiscouata-sur-le-lac on August 24, 2014 with activities, fireworks, music, etc.
