**Biographical information:** Helen Daigle was born on August 18, 1921 in Van Buren, Maine, the daughter of Dr. Wilfred J. Daigle and Rosalie Pelletier. Helen worked as a dental assistant for the father and later moved to New York City to be a nanny and dental assistant for Dr. Greengold. She returned to Fort Kent in the 1960s to care for her parents and to manage the Martin's Community Drug Store. She was employed as a customer sales representative at the Maine Public Service for many years. Helen was a past member of the Fort Kent BPW (Business and Professional Women) and a devoted member of the St. Louis Parish. She spent the last three

years of her life at the Crosswinds Health Care facility where she enjoyed the many activities offered. She was a proud and independent woman. Helen was a sister to Isabelle, Ludger, Oscar 'Bill', Jeanne, Fernand 'Freddy', and Louis. She was a loving and caring person to the many nieces and nephews she had. Helen passed away on October 23, 2013 in Fort Kent, Maine.

**Scope and content:** This collection consists mostly of vintage color and black and white postcards from the early twentieth century, a small prayer book, two religious images, a Christmas card, and an ash basket with a lid.

Most of the vintage postcards were sent and written by members of two families, Dr. Thomas H. Pelletier family of Van Buren, and Dr. Wilfred Joseph Daigle family of Fort Kent. Dr. Wilfred J. Daigle married Rosalie Pelletier, daughter of Dr. Thomas Pelletier. Helen Daigle is the daughter of Dr. Daigle and Rosalie Pelletier. The postcards date back to the early 20<sup>th</sup> Century and are all in excellent condition. Some postcards do not have written messages.

The twentieth century storage ash basket has a square base with a round neck and a lid. Some of the wefts are of reddish color. (Base 9 inch square; basket rim 10.5 inches in circumference; the lid conforms to the rim size; rim height 3-inches.)
