### **Scope and Content Note:**

This collection consists of an oral history interview with Finland (Finn) Dumond of Fort Kent, Maine, conducted by his nephew Andrew Dumond and Andrew's father George, of Fort Kent. Original label reads: Side A. Maine Studies – Interview with Fin Dumond of Fort Kent, spring 1990; Side B. "What life was like when he was 10 yrs old. Interview [sic] by Andy Dumond." The interview was recorded in the spring of 1990 as part of a 4<sup>th</sup> grade school project.

## **Biographical Notes:**

**Andrew Dumond** was a Fourth Grade student at the Fort Kent Elementary School at the time of the interview in the spring of 1990.

**George Dumond**, Andrew's father, assisted him with the interview. They lived on East Main Street in Fort Kent, Maine.

**Finland Dumond**, subject of the interview, is Andrew's grandfather residing on Market Street in Fort Kent, Maine at the time.
