### **Collection Description**

Historical and Biographical Information

This collection consists of papers belonging to two people: Edmund Bouchard Sr. & Edmund Bouchard Jr. Edmund Sr. was born in Fort Kent Maine and was the oldest of sixteen children. His estimated birth year is 1907 according to the 1940 census on ancestry.com.

Edmund Jr. was estimated to be born in 1931 according to the 1940 ancestry.com census. According to his brother, Paul, Edmund Jr. got married in 1954 and two years later moved to California for work at a phone company. After 20 years, he built a successful communications company, which his kids took over after his death. Edmund Bouchard Jr. died at age 66. He had five children- two daughters and three boys.

#### Scope and Content

The Bouchard Family Papers consist of two congratulatory letters on the Bouchards' 50th wedding anniversary from a Maine Congresswoman and Senator as well as a graduation certificate. These materials were donated by Edmund Bouchard Jr.'s nephew and his brother, Paul Bouchard came in to provide the processing archivist with a bit of more information on the materials and the people they pertain to.

The wedding anniversary congratulations belong to Edmund Boucher Sr. The graduation certificate belongs to Edmund Boucher Jr.
