## **Collection Description**

### Historical and Biographical Information

At the request of the president of the University of Maine at Fort Kent, “Les Chanteurs Acadiens” was formed in January 1988 to honor and promote the local Acadian-French culture and traditional French and Acadian folk songs at the Annual French Heritage Festival of UMFK, the first of which was held in the Spring of 1988. -Taken from page in first scrapbook

Since then the group has grown to as many as eight members but currently only has three members at the time his collection was donated (August 2022). The group has performed at events and functions such as UMFK’s board of Trustees meeting, Van Buren-St. Leonard’s “Celebration de la Grande Riviere, the Acadian Festival, and at the capitol building for the Maine State Legislature. The group has also recorded multiple albums, some of which the archive has in their collection as well as for sale. The current three remaining members of the “Les Chanteurs Acadiens” are Charles Stewart, Don Levesque, and Roger Damboise.

Ann Perreault-Levesque, a former member of the musical group, created these scrapbooks and after she died in 2014 (Bangor Daily News obituary), the scrapbooks came into the hands of Charles Stewart who donated the collection on behalf of the musical group.

### Scope and Content

This collection is mostly made up of photographs and memorabilia/programs from various performances by Les Chanteurs Acadiens as well as a brief biography of how the group was formed and its members at the time. Copies of songs and their origins were also pasted into the scrapbook as are thank you letters from people who watched their performances. The scrapbooks content appear to be organized more by material than dates as some of the materials skip between different years.

### Arrangement

This series has been split into three series: scrapbooks, framed photographs, and loose photographs. When the processing archivist came across this collection, the materials were grouped together on a shelf, which may not have been the original order, but in creating these series, the processing archivist tried to keep close to the collection’s original order.
