Conservation Notes

Staples and paperclips were taken out of manuscript materials. All materials that came to the archives in non-archival folders were removed from these and put in archival-grade neutral pH folders and boxes. Additionally, any materials housed in three-ring binders were taken out of their binders and put into archival folders. In some cases such as the 'St. Bruno Parish council meeting minutes 1976-1983', the dividers interwoven into the pages were kept with the papers in their original order. One or two binders were kept if in good enough condition and unique enough to warrant keeping, but in most cases, the binders were falling apart or posed a preservation hazard and had to be thrown out.

The photographs housed in scrapbooks were taken out of their scrapbook bindings, which were falling apart, posing a risk to the images themselves and put in clear archival sleeves and

enclosed photographic binders. Though the scrapbook exteriors had to be thrown out, they were described briefly by the processing archivist at the start of their respective series.

Due to mold, some boxes and materials had to be thrown out. See separation of materials section below for more information.

Series XVI consists of halftone print blocks, many of which are in poor condition, making it hard to see the images depicted on them clearly. Because of their condition and the fact that many do not have descriptions, they can't all be fully described or the people/places definitely identified. These half-tones should not be handled without the use of clean nitrile or similar impermeable gloves due to the risk of residues corroding the metal plates. They have been laid flat in modular storage boxes with the metal plates facing up.

Collection Description

Historical and Biographical Information

Jacques LaPointe, OFM, was born in Van Buren, Maine, and brought up in a large French-heritage family in the Saint-Léonard area of New Brunswick. He earned a bachelor's degree in political science and a master's in Acadian Studies at the Université de Moncton. He then traveled widely as an international liaison officer for the World University Service. After a near-death experience, he joined a pre-novitiate program at Holy Cross Friary in Bronx, New York. His ordination as a priest came in 1997.

Father LaPointe worked with immigrant communities in Maryland and New York. In 2010, he returned to the Upper St. John Valley as the administrator of a new consolidated parish, which he served for five years. This appointment enabled him to reconnect with his roots and serve the Acadian community. His dedication to Acadian heritage earned him induction into the Maine Franco-American Hall of Fame in 2013. In 2014 he was the past administrator of Notre-Dame-du-Mont Carmel cluster and is the current pastor of the St. Peter-Chanel parish. Father LaPointe served as the coordinator of the spiritual activities of the 2014 World Acadian Congress held in Maine and New Brunswick. He was then appointed to St. Anthony's Shrine in Boston.

He is the author of *Les enfants du ciel*, *Les étoiles et les clochers*, *Grande-Rivière: une page d'histoire acadienne*, and other works. The Acadian Archives exhibited his collection of maps in 2016. Father LaPointe now resides in Edmundston and provides spiritual counseling in hospitals and nursing homes. He continues to take interest in his ancestral culture. He celebrated mass on the occasion of Franco-American Day and the Madawaska Acadian Festival in 2022.

The parishes included in this collection are: St. David (Madawaska), St. Bruno, St. Remi (Keegan/Van Buren), St. Joseph (Hamlin & Caswell) and St. Thomas (Madawaska) all of which now fall under the jurisdiction of the Dioceses of Portland, ME. Due to a number of these parishes being combined, there isn't always a lot of information on the individual church histories readily available.

St. David church (St. David/Madawaska, ME): The first church at this location was built in 1871 and marked the end of a struggle for residents of Madawaska fighting for their own church and parish. Prior to this, they attended a parish in Saint-Basile, New Brunswick. The current church was built in 1911-12 and stands adjacent to the Tante Blanche Museum complex.¹

St. Thomas Aquinas church (Madawaska, ME) was established in 1929. The church merged with other parishes in 2007 and is now affiliated with St. David Church and St. Gerard Church (Grand Isle, ME) as part of the Notre Dame du Mont Carmel Parish.

St. Joseph church was established in 1921 in Hamlin plantation, which is located next to Van Buren.

St. Bruno chapel was erected in 1827 as one of two mission chapels created by Catholic parishioners from Quebec who made missions to the Saint John Valley area to promote their religion in the area. In 1838 St. Bruno became a full-fledged parish that has had a long history of serving its parishioners and working with the following religious orders: Good Shepherd Sisters, Third Order of Mary and Marist Fathers of Boston. In 2007, St. Bruno parish was merged with

the St. Remi (Keegan) and St. Joseph (Hamlin) parishes into one parish under the name of St. Peter Chanel. Prior to this, St. Remi was merged with St. Bruno church after the village of Keegan was merged with/incorporated into Van Buren.

La Societe de Marie/The order of Mary, also known as the **Marianists** was founded in Bordeaux, France in 1817 with the goal to sustain their faith and increase their members. The society's primary mission was to teach children and they shared their religious message through teachings. Marianist work also included social work in hospital, and orphanage settings.² The

Third order of Mary is part of the order of Mary/Marianists. The third order is class or level of service within the order.³ St. Mary's college in Van Buren was affiliated with the third order of Mary out of St. Bruno. There is very little information available on the college and its history, despite Archives staff researching it and reaching out to locals in the Van Buren area who are well versed in the town's history.

Good Shepherd Sisters are a Catholic order that serves communities in North America, Canada, and across the globe. They are one of the few orders that supports two lifestyles for its members- as an apostolic or contemplative sister. They focus on serving the impoverished and social justice issues like human services for women, children and families.⁴

Catholic Dioceses of Portland was established by Pope Pius IX in 1853 and included the states of Maine and New Hampshire until 1884 when it was split into two dioceses. The diocese is made up of 48 parishes, 10 elementary schools, a high school, and a college and serves over a quarter of a million Catholics in Maine.⁵

Catholic Charities Maine is a part of Catholic charities USA, which has ties to an international federation of catholic social services. The Maine branch has been helping the poor and vulnerable since 1966 with a wide variety of services from food services to child care to housing depending on a community's needs. They work with a number of religious orders, who have been offering these services for centuries in Maine.⁶

Scope and Content

Parish bulletins, meeting minutes, census books, prayer books, account ledgers & record books, financial documents, homilies, mass schedules, photographs and framed images, binders, music sheets, a/v materials, funeral cards, wood-backed zinc and copper etching plates, cannon law

books, newspapers, desk calendars, and metals depicting saints of the Catholic church. In 1973 the building was listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Arrangement

This collection came to the Acadian Archives with a lack of clear overall order; some materials were partially organized chronologically or by subject (i.e. mass bulletins) but most were not. The processing archivist determined the best route to take was to sort the collection into series by parish(es) or subject and from there, break the series down into subseries (i.e. church bulletins, centennial documents, etc.) and then file them chronologically. Some materials didn't have documentation that they belonged/came from a specific parish so they were put in their own series not affiliated with a parish. Because a few of the parishes merged and/or their documents were intermingled, these parishes' documents were kept together to avoid confusion (see St. Bruno & St. Remi; St. David, St. Gerard-Mt. Carmel & St. Thomas Aquinas parishes). In total, there are 17 series, most of which have numerous subseries by topic:

Separated Materials (If Applicable)

This collection was left in the care of the Acadian Archives whose staff has determined- with their best judgment and referencing archival standards- that a large portion (about three quarters) of the materials pertaining to minute parish financial records would be better suited to reside with the local Catholic Dioceses headquarters in Portland. Staff transferred these materials to the care of the Dioceses and kept materials pertaining to the Saint John Valley parishes that could be made readily available to researchers upon completion of processing the collection.

Proper deeds of gift forms were filled out and signed upon donation of this collection by the donor and Acadian Archives staff at the time of donations (2013-2014) According to one of the donor sheets, in 2015 about half a dozen boxes from the Madawaska Parish [no specification on which church] were returned to a member of the parish. Three boxes of empty envelopes were

also discarded by Archives staff a month after this event in March 2015. Two boxes of personal cards to Father Jacques from parishioners were also returned to Father Jacques due to the personal nature of the cards being unsuitable for public use.

One box of materials had to be discarded by Archives staff in 2022 due to the contents being moldy and a health hazard to humans as well as a preservation hazard to other materials. One small box of bricks and wood as well as a couple boxes of pottery, glass, and rocks were also discarded due to lack of significance/historical value.

Two scrapbooks were thrown out due to suspected mold on the outside covers. The materials within the scrapbooks themselves were kept and put into archival sleeves and binders. The processing archivist assessed photos/clippings for mold as she went through them. Three books: *Registre des Diverses Sociétés: Apostolat de la Prière, Garde d' Honneur à Marie, Garde d' Honneur a S.C. de Jésus*; *Registre des Ecoles: Gradues: Caswell & Hamlin*; *Ideal Eycline* Record book containing monthly and quarterly itemized list of monetary transactions (possible donations by patrons?) for the year of 1967; and a journal of people honored during masses dating from March 3, 1929- January 14, 1940 were thrown out due to them being covered in mold.

Throughout the collection, there were numerous copies of the same document. As is common practice, the processing archivist kept up to two copies of each document and discarded excess copies for space considerations unless the copies each had unique content/markings. The catholic Portland Diocese quarterly financial reports for St. Remi Parish were taken out of their envelopes to make them more accessible since many of the envelopes were sealed and/or had rusting metal tabs. But the envelopes were kept and put in separate folders within the same box and series as the financial records.

One book, *Van Buren Centennial 1881-1981*, compiled by Martine A. Pelletier was put in the stacks where it could be more widely circulated. The call no. is F29.V29 P44 1981.
