Collection Description

Historical and Biographical Information

The Ouellette family is one of the original Acadian families that settled in the St. John Valley region. The Ouellette family genealogy books were created as part of the Madawaska Acadian Festival, and presented to the family during the festival. According to Alain Ouellette, it sounds like this father was a member of their family's reunion committee which organized family reunions during the festival.

Alain donated these materials to the Archive after his father's passing as he wanted them to be preserved and made available to others interested in the Ouellette line of genealogy.

Scope and Content

This collection pertains to the genealogy of the Ouellette family and their 2004 family reunion.

Arrangement

This collection is divided into four series. Series I: genealogy volumes contains three genealogy books that are numbered volumes 1-3 and were kept in this order as it depicts the Ouellette family genealogy chronologically. Series II: newspaper clippings containing a few newspaper articles on the Ouellette family in relation to their family reunions and these books being compiled for them. These articles were left in their original order when put in an archival folder. Series III: Deprey family connections contains research notes papers corresponding to the Deprey family.

Separated Materials (If Applicable)

The genealogy books are housed in the archives' genealogy reference section with the rest of our genealogy books. The framed family tree is hung up on the archives reading room next to the genealogical materials and shelves.
