Modern replicas of two Acadian outfits (1 male and 1 female); miscellaneous clothing items; a small crucifixion cross hanging from a silver string (the latter two of which are modeled on mannequins.)

Provenance

Two of the costumes may have been donated by John and Norma Robichaud, but there is an overall lack of documentation for these outfits and attempts to contact the Robichauds did not lead anywhere.

All the costumes were housed in the Acadian Archives prior to current staff taking on their roles but were unprocessed and lacking the paperwork documenting their provenance which is why the archivist made the decision to put them in one collection together.
