Collection Description

Historical and Biographical Information

At the time of this interview (August 2019), Carl Theriault was 77 years old. Carl never received a formal education and spent his life working in the woods from a young age. At the age of 32, he had an accident 15 miles from Allagash (ca. 1974) when he was cutting wood with saws that resulted in a broken hand and leg and landed him in the Fort Kent hospital (now Northern Maine Medical Center) for 14 days before being sent down to Presque Isle.

Taylor Martin was born and raised in Fort Kent. In addition to working logging jobs, he works as a special education teacher in the Fort Kent school system. He conducted his interview in August 2019 with four of his students- Sadie Soucy, Brendan Nadeau, Hunter Dunnells [sic], & Evan Deschaine.

Scope and Content

This collection consists of two 11” x 8.5” color photographs and one 46 minute audio CD. One image is of Carol Theriault, who is in a wheelchair, with four students, two on each side of him with an International Tractor in the background. The other image is of Mr. Theriault in his wheelchair outside.
