Collection Description

Historical and Biographical Information

The Acadian Archives was established in the 1990s and started in one room on the second floor of Blake Library. Hon. John L. Martin, Hon. Judy Paradis, and others wrote funding into law to build a space for the Acadian Archives with state of the art preservation rooms. In the early 2000s, the Archives was moved to its current space between Blake Library and Powell hall.

Scope and Content
