### **Collection Description**

#### Historical and Biographical Information

Gertrude Daigle Reed graduated from the Madawaska Training School (now known as the University of Maine at Fort Kent) in 1922. She worked as a teacher for about 25 years in the St. Francis and Fort Kent Maine areas, including at the Violette Settlement. She married and had ten children.

Alice Daigle Young was also a graduate of the Madawaska Training school at a later date not known by her nephew. Like her sister, Alice, worked as a rural school teacher in Aroostook County, Maine for about thirty years.

### Scope and Content

Gertrude Daigle Reed's obituary cards over a brief overview of the lives of people that passed away in the St. John Valley or that were from the St. John Valley. Having memorial cards at a funeral for attendees to take home to remember the deceased is a common practice. Most of the cards have religious images or floral designs on the back.

Alice Daigle Young's scrapbook depicts her life as a teacher and different people she came into during her lifetime. It also includes clippings from different training schools. The scrapbook contains a mix of images, newspaper articles, and what appears to be brochure/magazine clippings. This scrapbook was brought to the Acadian Archives with some loose-leaf photos and documents; in order to preserve the originality of the scrapbook, these loose photos/documents were put in clear sleeves and left in between the pages they were found.

### Arrangement

The Obituary/prayer cards and business cards were brought to the Acadian Archives in a stack kept together with an elastic band. The Archives intern under the direction of the processing archivist put them in chronological order by the person's death date. A few of the cards didn't have a year, but Archives staff were able to research obituaries to find the year and made a note of it in the finding aid below as well as on the plastic sleeve they are housed in. In this stack there were also some undated business and prayer cards that were put at the end of the collection.

The scrapbook was kept in the original order it was brought to the Acadian Archives in, including the looseleaf photographs tucked in between pages.

## Series II: Scrapbook

Many of the photographs have descriptions written in their pages and these are copied on this finding aid in parentheses and the archivist's supplemental descriptions are left as plain text. Some pages have markings or signs that a photograph was once attached to the pages but no longer is. It's possible- and likely- that some of the loose-leaf photographs were once attached to pages and came loose with time but due to the processing archivist not knowing which photograph went where, these places were left empty and their notations jotted down with the inscription "missing photograph".
