## **Collection Description**

## Historical and Biographical Information

Rella Emelie Cote was born in October, 1912 to Victorie Cote and Flevie<sup>1</sup> Cyr. She was the fourth youngest of eight children born to the couple. Victorie was a shoe repairman on what is

believed to be Main Street. His backyard abutted the river and the Cote family lived above the shoe shop.

Rella graduated from the grammar school at 15 but was unable to attend high school because she needed to help her mother care for her three younger siblings and work odd jobs. Rella left Fort Kent around 1930 to join her three older sisters. She worked in shoe shops, restaurants as a waitress, and in textile mills. Rella married her husband on November 11, 1940 and became a full time homemaker when her son was born in 1946.

Rella visited her parents at least once a year in Fort Kent when all eight of their children gathered together. Her son doesn't believe she ever went back to Fort Kent after her parents moved to Lewiston in 1953.

Rella was a voracious reader. She passed away in Biddeford in 1988, predeceased by her husband who passed in 1987.
