The Acadians were a group of French settlers and their descendants who settled in what are the present day Maritime provinces of Canada. When the British wanted the land, many Acadians were expelled from their homelands to other colonies, back to France or other colonies such as those in the Caribbean. Some Acadians were able to flee ahead of the forced expulsion, and many unfortunately perished. This map serves as an in-depth visual for the migration/expulsion patterns of the Acadians.
