Collection Description

Historical and Biographical Information

The Madawaska Training School was established February 21, 1878 by the Maine Legislature "for the purpose of training persons to teach in the common schools of the [Madawaska] territory." Originally the school year was split between separate locations at Fort Kent and Van

Buren (1879-1883) or Fort Kent and Grand Isle (1884-1887), but in 1888 the Legislature established a year-round facility at Fort Kent. Once the school was permanently located at Fort Kent, it became necessary to provide lodging for students from other parts of the Saint John Valley. A boarding house "convenient in arrangements and sufficiently commodious for the accommodation of forty to fifty students" opened in 1893. Those staying at the boarding house paid no rent, but "they did have to bear their proportionate share of HEATING, LIGHTING, and supplying their home with water, an equivalent \$1.50 per month" (Grindle, Roger. The University of Maine at Fort Kent: A century of progress, p. 30).

The Madawaska Training school was renamed the Fort Kent State Normal School in 1955 and then had its name changed four more times, eventually sticking with the University of Maine at Fort Kent in 1979. Despite these name changes, the institution has always remained the same entity.

David Bourgoin, who found this artifact was a history buff who lived in Connecticut, but had roots in Madawaska. He found these reports in the wall of a building he owned on Main street in Fort Kent, Me. He framed the reports and hung them in his home for many years. In the process of downsizing, his partner donated them on his behalf after he passed away.

Scope and Content

Four report cards listing the grades Mary Pinette received in her classes. The pages are half page sheets with a header from the Madawaska Training School and signed by her teachers. The frame is made of dark wood with a gold-colored inset and a glass plate covering the reports.

Report cards are framed chronologically by year from top left-bottom right.
