Collection Description

Historical and Biographical Information

The State of Maine Moose Lottery is an annual drawing of moose hunting permits. The lottery was held in Augusta until 1998. Since then, the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife has announced the winners in a new location every year. In 2024, the event was held at Riverside

Park in Fort Kent on June 15, the same weekend as the local Ploye Festival. Food trucks, performers, and vendors—including the Acadian Archives team—were present to cater to the large number of attendees.
