No biographical information for Paul and Rose Chassé is available.

Blanche Pelletier was born on June 11, 1915 in St. Agatha, Maine, the daughter of Alexis "Alec" Levesque and Dorimène "Dorine" Soucy. She grew up along la petite rivière region (the area along Clevel and Road) where her father ran a grist mill and, later, a saw mill. She attended school in a local district school through the eighth grade and married at the age of nineteen to Arthur (Arthy) Pelletier (1913-2006) on April 3, 1934, in Madawaska. Mr. Pelletier worked as a contractor. She died on September 27, 2008.

Roland G. Pelletier was the son of Blanche and Arthur Pelletier.

No biographical information for Linda Chassé Pelletier is available.

Scope and Content Note:

Two C-60 audio cassettes containing an interview with Paul and Rose Chassé conducted by Ronald and Linda Pelletier. The Chassés discuss stories from their lives and childhoods, including a story about a theft of a large sum of money in Caribou, Maine. The recording also includes an interview with and songs by Ronald's mother Blanche Pelletier. This interview recording was submitted for a course at the University of Maine at Fort Kent in Spring 1974.
