This collection consists of 55 index cards containing transcriptions of epitaphs from the Catholic and Congregational cemeteries in St. Francis, Maine and Catholic and Baptist cemeteries in Allagash, Maine. Each epitaph card includes the deceased person's name, birth year, and death year. The collection also includes a French typescript, "Lang ou Long," reporting the genealogy of the Lang/Long family. These materials were submitted for a course at the University of Maine at Fort Kent in Spring 1977.
