The Blake Library's hours of operation are as follows:

Monday thru Thursday 8:00 A.M to 11:00 P.M.,

Friday 8:00 A.M to 4:30 P.M.,

Saturday 12:00 P.M to 4:00 P.M.,

Sunday 1:00 P.M. until 9:00 P.M.

Any changes in the schedule for reasons such as a holiday, will be posted.

Activate your campus email account and then check it regularly. We are currently emailing students their overdue notices. This makes it easier and faster to let students know whether or not they have an overdue book.

All students must come to the library to confirm his or her local address with the library staff. This will prevent bills and other correspondence from being sent to your home address while you are at UMFK.

If anyone would like to renew an overdue book, there are four ways of doing so:

For anyone who renews a book using URSUS, first you click on Find a Book, then at the bottom of the page you click to view your account. Note: Forgetting to renew books will cost you \$.50/day/per item. Losing an item will result in a \$45 fee. Charges on your library account will prevent you from registering for classes, receiving your official transcripts, receiving semester grades and getting your diploma.

The following is a reminder of the loan periods on items.

Curriculum= 1 week (1 week renewal)

Journals, Reference, and Special Collections= Do Not Check Out

Juvenile= 2 Weeks (1 week renewal)

Young Adult, Gov Docs, Oversize, and Regular Stacks= 4 wks (2 wks renewal)
