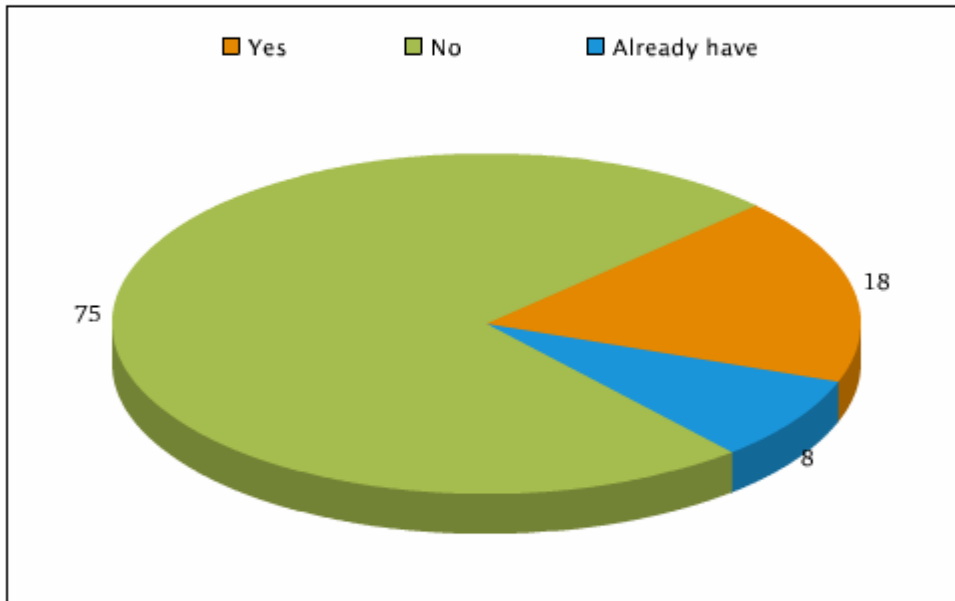

Did you know that as a UMFK student, faculty, and staff you can receive free antivirus software for your computer?

Students, faculty, and staff can pick up a free Symantec anti-virus software CD from the IT department located on the second floor of the new archives building. The software updates itself as long as faculty, staff, and students remain members of the campus community.

The software does not include spyware or spam control, and in order for the software to work properly, other anti-virus software should be removed from your computer.

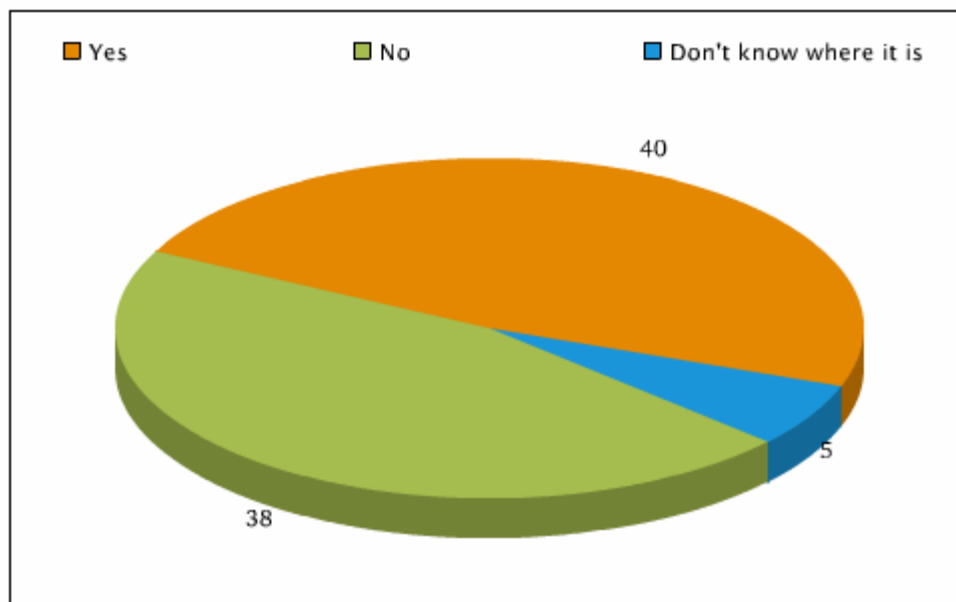

So even if you purchased an anti-virus CD at the beginning of the year, unless you pay for the regular updates, you will not catch new viruses. Did you know you could find out if a journal is available online either in full text or for citations by using our "Serials Solutions" resource?

Serials Solutions is a great resource that allows you to find what journals are available online in one or more of our databases. This means if you are trying to find an article in a particular journal, then you can: search Serials Solutions, find the database(s) the journal is in, then locate the article by clicking on the correct year and volume. Once you find the article you will have either the citation (the information you need so library staff can borrow it from another library for you), full text options (immediate access to the article), or the issue may be available here in our library.

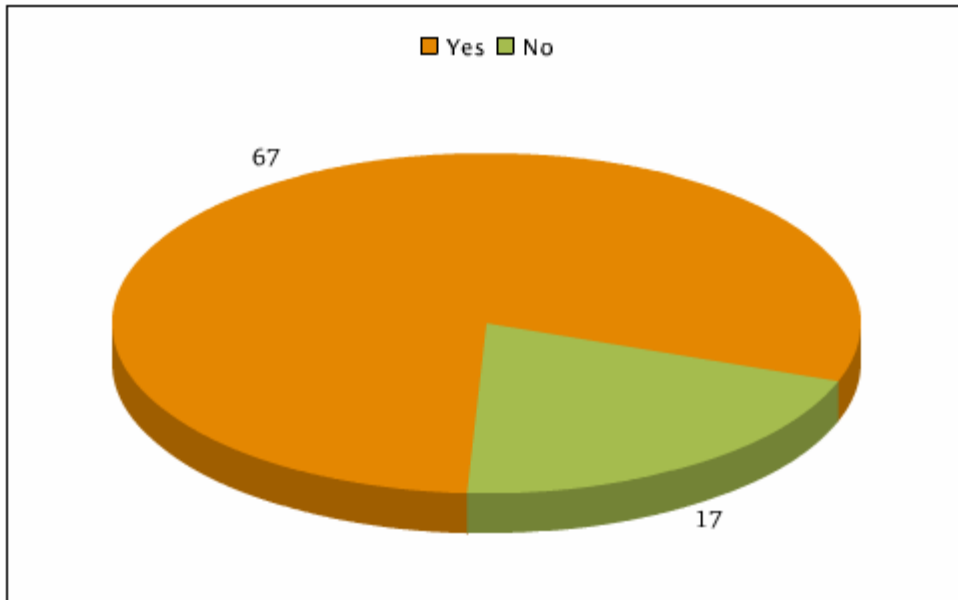

To go straight to the Marvel site to get started go to the [Home Page](#). You will need to set up a free account. Once you are in, you will find many resources available at your fingertips.

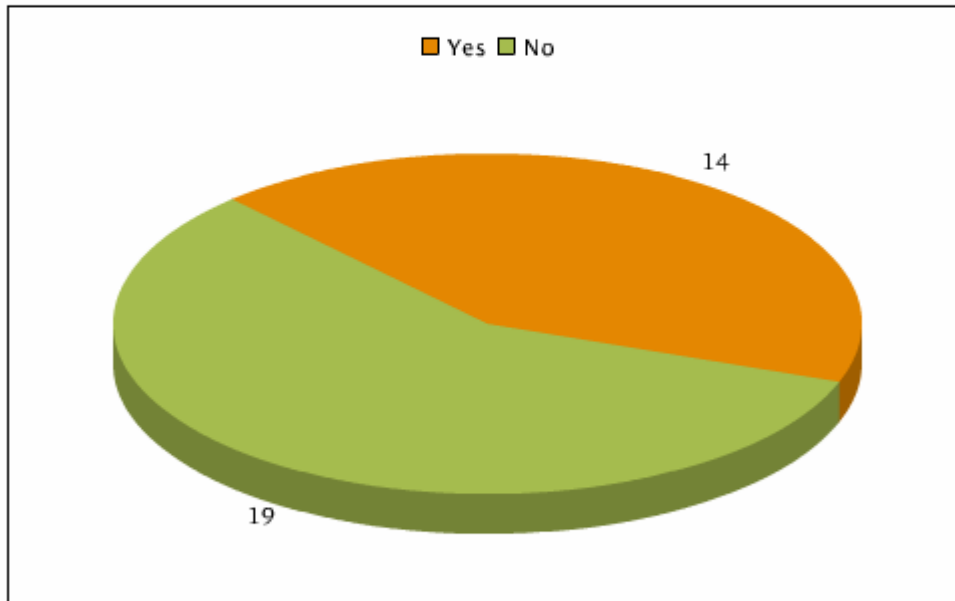
Students! Use this site if you can't find your student ID or it isn't working (but be sure to let us know if your ID isn't working). Many of the databases offered here are the same as what we offer.

Did you know we had a 24 hour computer lab on campus which requires an access card for after hours use?

The Nadeau 109 lab is the 24 hour access lab. During business hours, Monday through Friday, students may go to the Student Services office in Cyr Hall to get an access (proximity) card. There is a \$10 deposit which students will get back once the card is returned.

When the lab is closed there is an outside access to the lab coming from the park side of the campus. Just inside the first door there is a swipe machine where students use the card to allow them access into the lab.
