



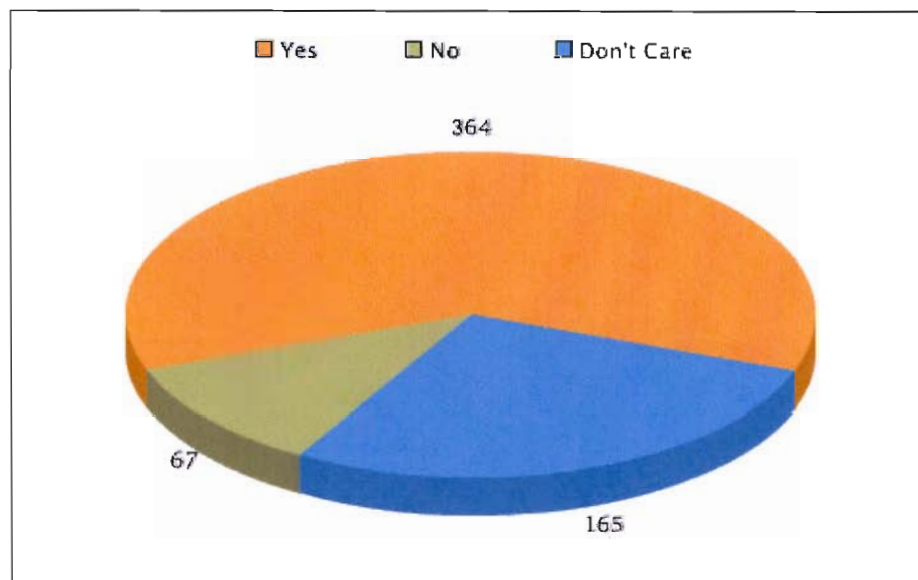

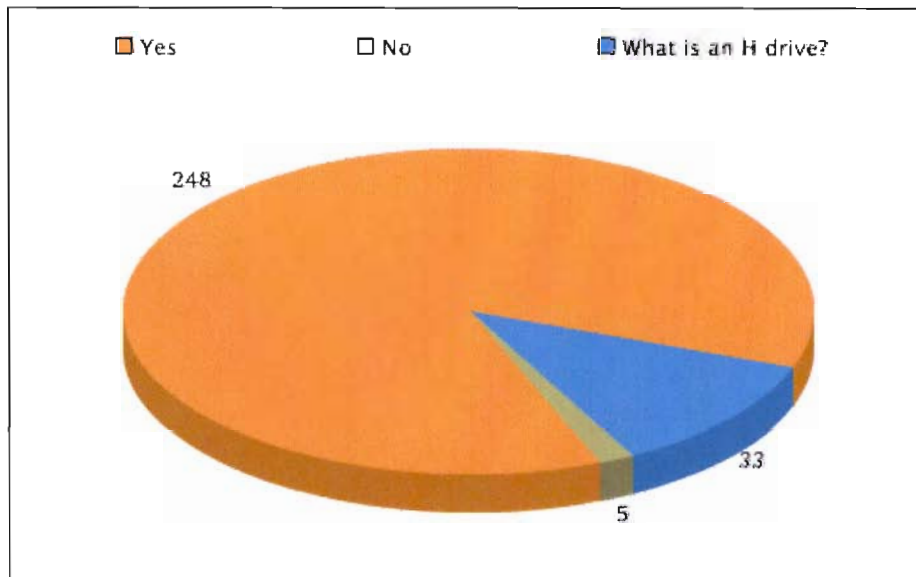

If you answered yes, you are in luck! Just this summer the IT department was able to provide students secure access to their H drive from the dorms or home. Access is available from any Windows computer as well as a Macintosh computer. To gain access to your H drive you must have or do the following:

- Connection to the internet (high speed broadband is recommended)
- Read and accept IT's "Acceptable usage policy" before printing or downloading the tutorial manual from the UMFk website at <http://www.umfk.maine.edu/it/tutorials/>

If you don't already know, The H drive is simply a location on a UMFk server, much the same as the C drive on your personal computer. However, the H drive is accessible based on your campus login. The H drive is a great place to save files you are working on, and it's a great tool to use when you want to work on your files both at home and on campus. By using your H drive, you no longer have to worry if the disk you saved your file on will work once you get to campus.
