#### Serials

#### **General statistics:**

- The current serials collection consists of 259 titles
  - o 211 are paid subscriptions
  - o 48 are gifts/free,
    - 12 are purchased with the Inez Day Richards fund.
    - 2 are gifts from the LOAR fund.
- Last year 94 titles were cancelled
  - o 11 were added to the collection. Of the 11 titles added to the collection, 10 are paid subscriptions.
- Blake Library patrons also have access to over 27,408 unique titles as electronic journal subscriptions, which are accessible through various full-text databases (or even more conveniently through SerialsSolutions).
- In FY2009 33 titles were routed to 14 faculty. These figures are higher than last fiscal year's numbers of 22 titles routed to 11 faculty.

#### Serials usage, including microfilm:

- In FY2009 120 titles were shelved a total of 2,052 times (see Tables 1-3)
- In FY2009 4 titles on microfilm were used 6 times. The titles most used were the *American Journal of Nursing (2) and the Saint John Valley Times (2)*.
  - o In FY2008, microfilm use included 12 titles used 17 times.
- In FY2009, 23 separate titles were checked out by a total of 11 faculty and staff. Items were checked out a total of 29 times.

### **Electronic journals:**

• 64 journals are available online (not including databases) (see Table 4).

#### **Continuing projects and goals:**

- Complete discarded of selected dead titles
- Move all serials to shelving out front, rather than shelving some titles directly out back, creating more immediate access for patrons.
