Acquisitions FY2016

All items received and/or paid for during FY2016 are counted as an acquisition for FY2016. Any items not received or paid for in FY2016 are not counted in FY2016.

- In FY2016 234 items were purchased totaling \$47,348.55.
 - This is a 36% decrease in the number of items purchased and a 10% increase in the total amount spent from last year. In FY2015, 366 items were purchased totaling \$42,937.44.
- This year 81 titles included in the acquisitions figures were purchased with funds received from gift accounts, totaling \$2,917.42.
 - o In FY2016 the library purchased 50 titles totaling \$2,617.34 from the Inez Day Richards funds. This amount spent increased by 60% from last year's purchases of \$1,632.63.
 - This amount includes monograph, serial, and database purchases.
 - o In FY2016 the President's Office purchased 7 titles totaling \$262.66.
 - o In FY2016 the library purchased 2 titles totaling \$37.42 from the Library Gift fund.
- In FY2016 the library purchased 20 PDA (patron-driven acquisitions) titles totaling \$887.40. These purchases include both physical and digital items.
- The largest concentrations of purchases by cost are as follows: Nursing 29%, Math/Science 20%, Social Science 15%, Education 13%, Humanities 12%, and Business 5%.
- The largest concentrations of purchases by volume count are as follows: Humanities 36%, Math/Science 13%, Nursing 10%, Social Science 10%, Education 9%, and Business 7%.
