Organizational history:

The Madawaska Training School was established through an act signed and approved by Maine governor Selden Connor on February 21, 1878. In the early years of the school's history, the location for the training of teachers alternated between Fort Kent and Van Buren, and in 1884 the school serving the lower section of the territory moved from Van Buren to Grand Isle. The money was appropriated for building permanent facilities for the school in Fort Kent, and the school finally had a permanent location and facility by the 1888-1889 school year. The name of the school was changed to Fort Kent State Normal School in 1955. Under its new name, the school saw its fourth and final principal, Joseph "Joe" Fox, who served the school from 1956 to 1971. Though originally the fourth principal of the school, he served long enough to see the school become a four-year college and change names three times; first to Fort Kent State Teacher's College in 1961, then to Fort Kent State College and finally to the University of Maine at Fort Kent in 1970. Scope and content:

This collection consists of records and materials gathered by Blake Library Special Collections from various university sources, all pertaining to the University of Maine at Fort Kent. Some of these materials have been donated to the library through the years, some were rescued from campus building flooding in 2008. Included in this collection are manuscripts and typescripts, records, meeting minutes, images, realia, brochures, and many other types of items.

This is an artificial collection created by Blake Library Special Collections and is continuously growing. As such, the material folders have not been individually numbered. However, a current (and continually updated) folder listing is attached to this finding aid.

This collection is divided into 14 series, based on the current UMFK organizational structure: general materials; Board of Trustees; Office of the Chancellor; Office of the President; Executive Assistant to the President; Development and special events; Vice President for Academic Affairs; class records and histories; academic divisions; Vice President for Administration; human resources; University relations; student affairs; and University of Maine System.

Some of the series currently do not contain materials, but have been designated in preparation for future inclusions. Some

series are subdivided into subseries, however, since these may change and grow frequently, they are not included in the scope and content, but appear in the file inventory.
